Intercept suicide at the gates of healthcare.

- Increase the number of healthcare professionals ready to intercept suicide.
- Increase the number of graduating students ready to intercept suicide.

Idaho State Plan Goal Alignment

Goal 7 – Expand knowledge of community and clinical service providers on nature, related behaviors, and prevention of suicide.

Goal 8 – Embed suicide prevention as a core component of health care services.

Expanding Efforts

Collaboration with Capacity Building and Infrastructure KPA to provide trainings to post-secondary students.

Analyze Data

Training data begins to be analyzed, and participants are encouraged to finish the course.

Follow-up Data

To understand retention, KPA is following up with participants, requesting they complete a 6-month post-training survey.
