Traumatic experiences have consistently been correlated with negative health outcomes across an individual's life span, including up to a 20-year reduction in life expectancy and a 30-40% increase in the incidence of substance use.

Trauma Informed Care (TIC) is an evidence-based framework particularly suited to collaboratively identify risk factors to care, such as medication access and use, therapeutic engagement, and non-medical resource needs and navigation.
