




## **CATIE Trial**

•1,158 participants w/ psychosis


- •96% remained above threshold for consent related decision capacity over 18-months
- •4% fell below
- •25% had a period of worsening








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






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
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










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Describe a situation in which an individual you are working with is facing an important decision or choice:

Segl wants us to take her to an interview and drop her off. But she doesn't know the name of the business, and the location is in a residential area. We are worried she is being lured into an unsafe situation.

What would overprotective responses to the situation be?

She's lacking insight - she should go back to the hospital

Take her to her favorite restaurant during the interview time

No - that's not a good choice. Let's look for something different

What would neglectful responses to the situation be?

Drop her off at the interview - fingers crossed!

It's her life, her choice. We'll let her make her own choice

She'll just have to suffer the natural consequences

What action(s) might you take that uphold the Duty to Care AND the Dignity of Risk?


Review information about employment scams

Ask the employer to conduct the interview in a public place




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Step 1: Describe the decision you are facing:
Olanzapine helps quiet my voices. But it has caused me to gain weight and now my blood sugar is high. Should I switch to another medicine?

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




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


Upholding the the Duty to Care and Dignity of Risk

- Explore the pros/cons




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**Decision Support** for Mohammed
