Annie Harper has a PhD in cultural anthropology, and works as an instructor in Yale University's Department of Psychiatry. She conducts research on how vulnerable populations, particularly low income people with mental illness, cope with poverty and financial difficulties, and how to support them in this area. She is particularly interested in understanding how the financial services and retail industries could better serve low income people generally, and people with mental illness in particular.
