

Suicide Risk Assessment Training

The Southeast MHTTC, in partnership with Georgia HOPE, is pleased to offer the Suicide Risk Assessment Training on **Friday, May 31, 2019** at **The Task Force for Global Health,** 330 West Ponce de Leon Ave, Decatur, GA 30030 from 9:30 AM to 2:30 PM.

Suicide Risk Assessment is an interactive training targeted to Master's level and licensed mental health clinicians who provide counseling and/or assessment in a variety of settings. The training will highlight the importance of suicide risk assessment and demonstrate ways clinicians can recognize, assess, and intervene when working with at-risk clients. After completing the training, participants should be able to

- 1. Implement the components of effective suicide risk assessment.
- 2. Discuss the elements of suicide risk assessment that have been determined to be "best practice,"
- 3. Discuss key elements in completing an effective crisis and safety response plan, and
- 4. Identify appropriate agency, professional, clinical, and social


