#### State Mental Health Agency: The Department of Behavioral Health and Developmental Disabilities (DBHDD)


#### State Mental Health System

DBHDD provides mental health services through six regional field offices, which work to:

- Oversee statewide initiatives
- Develop new services and expand existing services as needed
- Monitor the services being received by consumers to ensure quality and access

#### Training Opportunities in Georgia

- DBHDD hosts an annual <u>behavioral health symposium</u>
- The <u>Georgia Health Policy Center</u> provides technical assistance for first episode psychosis, as well as high fidelity wrap-around, recovery-oriented cognitive therapy, trauma-informed systems, emerging adult populations, cultural and linguistic competence
- The Georgia Mental Health Consumer Network (GMHCN) provides peer specialist certification and training
