

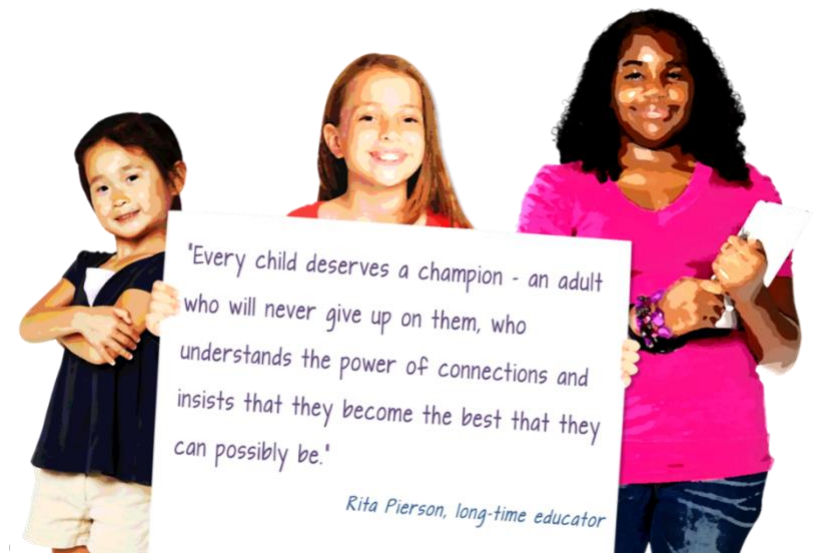


Positive Affirmations

Including positive affirmations in your classroom makes the physical space feel and look brighter and warmer while encouraging growth. Additionally, teachers can have students repeat the affirmation to positively re-center the classroom and gently remind students why they are there.
