New Jersey School Mental Health Resource Directory

While schools serve as a natural setting for student mental health services, relying solely on school-based staff and resources may create system strains and inadequately meet all student needs. Building partnerships and utilizing collaborations with community health organizations can broaden access to mental health care.¹ To support New Jersey schools and districts with identifying potential system partners, the Northeast & Caribbean Mental Health Technology Transfer Center (MHTTC) has developed the New Jersey School Mental Health Resource Directory. This directory includes nearly 200 organizations throughout the state of New Jersey that provide mental health services to children and adolescents. When utilizing the directory schools and districts may find it most helpful to:

- 1. determine the types of services for which support is needed,
- 2. use the directory key to identify the type of organizations that may be applicable, and
- 3. search by county for organizations that fit your needs.

It may also be helpful to check for community partners in surrounding counties as many organizations provide services across county lines. Please note this directory is not an exhaustive list of community care providers and is intended to provide schools and districts with a starting point for developing mental health system partners.

School Mental Health Resource Key:

Behavioral Health Services Provider

Provide direct mental health care to children and/or adolescents. This can include individual therapy, group therapy, family therapy, substance use treatment, crisis intervention, mobile response, and inpatient services. Many of these organizations also provide youth development programs and school-based services or programs.

Schools may find these organizations helpful as referral sites for students in need of services or may consider forming partnerships with these organizations to offer programs or services in the school setting.

Care Management Organization

Each county has a designated Care Management Organization (CMO). CMOs provide a full range of treatment and support services for children and adolescents. These organizations will work with families to develop service plans and connect families to treatment programs or other supports.

Schools may find these organizations helpful as referral sites for students in need of services. These organizations may be able to help connect students and families to appropriate services outside of the school.

Community Support Organization ද්ෂ

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These organizations provide support to families and the larger community on child and/or adolescent mental health. Programs may include educational programming, outreach, advocacy, and/or technical assistance. In some instances, these organizations may also provide direct mental health services.

Schools may find these organizations helpful in the development of mental health programs for their students and establishing systems of support for students and families.

Boards and Agencies

These organizations are government entities intended to promote well-being for children and/or adolescents.

Schools may work with these organizations to address barriers to school mental health on a county or state level. These organizations may also be helpful in identifying existing programs or services that can be utilized by schools.








Bergen County





Cape May County


