

Overview

This past year proved to be a busy and productive year for the Mid-America MHTTC. In Year 5, team members put the finishing touches on a full-scale implementation manual covering integrated primary care, produced multiple webinar series, developed toolkits on integrated primary care and gender affirming care practices, hosted serious mental illness learning communities, built new continuing education opportunities, and traveled across the country for conferences. The full scope of the Center's work is hard to condense into just one page — here are the highlights.

By the Numbers

86.48% — surveyed trainees were **satisfied** or **very satisfied** with Y5 trainings

6,572 – number of times products + resources were accessed online

43 – new products + resources available online

2,748 – participants received training

100 – total events held

Integrated Primary Care Manual

Integrated Primary Care is the Mid-America MHTTC's area of focus. During Y5, the Center completed one of their largest projects in this specialty — *Pediatric Integrated Primary Care: An Implementation and Training Manual for Professionals*.


